

ABSTRACT

Title : Factors Affecting the Senior High School Students' English Language Learning Problems: A Case Study at Sanorpittayakom School Yarang District Pattani Province

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This research aimed to study factors affecting senior high school students' English language learning problems: A case study at Sanorpittayakom school Yarang district Pattani province. The samples were 53 senior high school students who were studying at Sanorpittayakom school Yarang district Pattani province. The instrument used for data collection was five-rating scale questionnaire. The data were analyzed for percentage, average value and standard deviation.

The results of the research indicated that the internal factors affecting to the problems in English learning of senior high school students were at a moderate level ($\bar{x} = 3.37$) as well as external factors affecting problems in English learning of senior high school students were at a moderate level ($\bar{x} = 3.44$). Focusing on the average value and standard deviation from the factors both internal and external, it was shown that students who have good contextual factors will be able to have advantage in learning English build their learning successfully. Additionally, the results of this research can be of benefit to the school director, teachers and parents or the authorities that set school policy to improve the ability of students to use the English language well.
